DURATION & Intakes

The biggest advantage of UK education in comparison to other educational destinations worldwide is that, UK provides programs of shorter duration.

■ Duration

- **Bachelor's:** 3 years (4 years in Scotland)
- **Master's:** 1 year (2 years with placement/internship also available)
- **Integrated Masters:** 4 years (5 years in Scotland)

■ Intakes

UK Universities have mainly two intakes:

- **September – Fall Intake – All courses are open**
- **January – Spring Intake – Not all courses are open**
- However, many universities offer courses commencing in **May/June**, making it a minor intake



English Language Requirements



■ Types of English tests accepted

- Tests like IELTS, PTE, TOEFL and many more are accepted in UK.
- Applicants must achieve decent level of English by completing a successful 'Secure English Language Test' or SELT.

■ Note:

- **An IELTS waiver** is available as per the student's profile.
- **Pre-Sessional English Language program** is also offered for students who do not meet the IELTS requirements of a particular course at a University.

Entry Requirements



Entry Requirements for Bachelor's

- To be eligible, It requires first-class in 12th standard.
- For Engineering degrees, a score of 60% - 85% is required in Mathematics & Physics in 12th Standard depending on the university.
- For Business degrees a score of 55% - 85% is required in Mathematics depending on the University and other relevant subjects in 12th standard with few exceptions where the Mathematics score in 10th Standard is considered.

IELTS Requirements:

- IELTS requirement ranges from 6.0 / 6.5 with no band less than 5.5 depending upon the course and the University.

Entry Requirements for Master's

- To be eligible, you should have completed a bachelor's degree in a related field with a minimum score of 50%.

IELTS Requirements:

- IELTS requirement ranges from 6.0 / 6.5 with no band less than 5.5 depending upon the course and the University.
- Some UK Universities also accepts MOI –Medium of Instruction from graduating University to waive off the IELTS.



Types of Scholarships

- **University-specific Scholarships**

UK universities offer various scholarships for international students, such as the Clarendon Fund at Oxford and the President's Scholarships at Imperial College London.

- **Subject-specific Scholarships**

These scholarships target specific fields, funded by universities or industry partners to promote excellence—for example: STEM, arts, and medical scholarships.

- **Merit-based Scholarships**

Merit scholarships reward academic excellence from previous education covering some part of tuition and sometimes living expenses.

- **Need-based Scholarships**

These need-based scholarships cover tuition, living expenses, and other study-related costs in the UK, typically based on financial need.

- **Country-specific Scholarships**

These scholarships promote global ties, targeting students from specific countries. Funded by the UK government or partner organizations, examples include GREAT Scholarships and bilateral agreement scholarships.

- **Athletic Scholarships:**

These scholarships support talented athletes, covering tuition, living expenses, and training costs, and are often awarded by universities with robust sports programs.
