2. CPT can be full time or part time.

After studies

Optional Practical Training (OPT)

1. Provides opportunity to gain actual employment experience.
2. CPT can be full time or part time.

1. Eligible student may request OPT in order to be employed in a position related to the major area of study.
2. 12/36 months of OPT available after each degree level completion.

Scholarship Opportunities

■ Government-funded Scholarships

These scholarships are provided by the U.S. government to support international students. Examples include the Fulbright Program and the Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program,

■ University-specific Scholarships

Many U.S. universities offer their own scholarships to attract talented international students. These scholarships can be merit-based, need-based, or specific to certain programs or departments.

■ Private Sector Scholarships

Various corporations and foundations offer scholarships to international students. Examples include the Microsoft Scholarships and Google Lime Scholarship.

■ Joint Scholarships

Programs such as the Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship provide mid-career professionals with opportunities for non-degree academic study and professional development.

■ Professional Development Scholarships

Collaborative scholarships like the Joint Japan/World Bank Graduate Scholarship Program offer financial support for students from developing countries to pursue graduate studies in development-related fields at selected U.S. universities.


